4	1	TRAINS - STEAM LOCOMOTIVE : AFTER WINDING THROUGH NARROW ROCK CUTTINGS THE LINE EMERGES INTO A WIDE HIGH SIDED VALLEY THROUGH WHICH IT CLIMBS TOWARDS A TUNNEL AT THE SUMMIT - A LLANELLY BOUND FREIGHT TRAIN CLIMBS PAST THROUGH THE VALLEY ON THE GRADIENT TOWARDS THE TUNNEL / THE TRAIN IS HEADED BY AN UNIDENTIFIED 8F ASSISTED BY THE KNIGHTON BANKING ENGINE NO. 48420 /	1961 Night.	3:30	STEREO
5	1	TRAINS - STEAM LOCOMOTIVE : THE LAST DOWN EXPRESS OF THE DAY FROM PADDINGTON HAS BEEN STOPPED AT NEARBY SIGNALS / A SIGNAL ARM LOWERS & NO. 6013 MOVES CAUTIOUSLY PAST THE SIGNALS WHERE THE ATC SIREN SOUNDS IN THE ENGINE'S CAB & HEADS THE TRAIN AWAY UNDER A ROAD BRIDGE TOWARDS THE STATION / MEANWHILE ANOTHER TRAIN IS MOVING SOMEWHERE IN THE FAR DISTANCE & A HEAVY DELAYED UP EXPRESS - APPROACHING IN THE DISTANCE FROM THE NORTH - CREEPS SLOWLY TOWARDS THE STATION WHERE NO. 6013 WHISTLES WHEN GIVEN A CLEAR ROAD & TAKES THE DOWN EXPRESS AWAY / THE UP EXPRESS FROM BIRMINGHAM IS ALSO GIVEN A CLEAR ROAD & APPROACHES IN THE DISTANCE - THROUGH THE STATION - ACCELERATING VIGOROUSLY / NO. 6022 BURSTS OUT FROM UNDER THE ROAD BRIDGE - HEADS THE TRAIN PAST IN A SHALLOW CUTTING & CLIMBS AWAY (GREAT BRITAIN)	1961 Night.	5:22	STEREO

6	1	TRAINS - STEAM LOCOMOTIVE : NEAR LLAVIHANGEL STATION - NO. 5322 STANDS WAITING IN THE LOOP LINE NEAR THE STATION - GENTLY HISSING STEAM AT THE HEAD OF A SOUTHBOUND LOOSE COUPLED FREIGHT TRAIN / MEANWHILE A SOUTHBOUND FITTED FREIGHT TRAIN APPROACHES IN THE DISTANCE ON THE LONG CLIMB FROM HEREFORD / NO. 6834 WHISTLES PAST THE STATION - HEADS THE FITTED FREIGHT TRAIN UNDER A ROAD BRIDGE & W/ THE REGULATOR EASED TAKES THE TRAIN OVER THE SUMMIT & AWAY INTO THE DISTANCE / WHEN THE LINE IS CLEAR NO. 5322 GURGLES - WHISTLES - STARTS SLOWLY OUT FROM THE LOOP - HEADS THE LOOSE COUPLED FREIGHT TRAIN UNDER THE BRIDGE & STOPS TO ALLOW SOME WAGON BRAKES TO BE PINNED DOWN BEFORE RESUMING THE DOWNHILL JOURNEY	1960 Night.	7:10	STEREO
7	1	TRAINS - STEAM LOCOMOTIVE : AT GRESFORD HALT - A FREIGHT TRAIN IS APPROACHING IN THE DISTANCE - MAKING SLOW PROGRESS ON THE CLIMB / THE ENGINE SEEMS TO BE MAKING STRANGELY LITTLE EFFORT TO TACKLE THE CLIMB W/ A HEAVY TRAIN & IS HISSING STEAM & INTERMITTENTLY BUZZING ANGRILY AS IT ROUNDS A CURVE - LOSES ADHESION & STAGGERS PAST AT LITTLE MORE THAN WALKING PACE / NO. 6861 DRAGS THE TRAIN AWAY ROUND A CURVE BELOW THE WOODS & OUT INTO THE OPEN WHERE PROGRESS ON THE CONTINUING CLIMB IS INTERMITTENTLY INTERRUPTED BY FREQUENT BOUTS OF SLIPPING (GREAT BRITAIN)	1964 Night.	7:48	STEREO
